Cabin camp includes a wide variety of activities including crafts, nature study, archery, games, campfires, and more! NOTE: All 6th grade campers will be assigned to Cabin Camp!

...an advanced camping experience for 7th and 8th grade campers (grades as of spring 2019). Campers sleep in tents, cook their meals over a campfire, and spend their days canoeing and learning other camping skills.

Only 7th and 8th grade campers will be assigned to Outpost Camp. ALL 6th grade campers will be assigned to Cabin Camp due to the limited space at Outpost. Also, at this time there is NO "bring a non 4-H friend" option for Outpost.
