ROCK COUNTY 4-H ENROLLMENT GUIDELINES

4-H Membership Policies:

- A. Youth in Kindergarten (5K) as of October 1 are eligible to enroll in the Wisconsin 4-H program. Kindergarten (5K), 1st and 2nd graders will participate in 4-H as Cloverbuds. Youth will continue to be eligible for 4-H membership through the next 4-H year beyond high school graduation and not to extend beyond the age of 19 as of December 31 of the enrollment year.
- B. The Wisconsin 4-H membership year is October 1 September 30. 4-H enrollments will be accepted at any time during the year.
- C. Deadlines:

March 1 - New members enrolling by this date may exhibit at the county fair.After March 1 - Members may enroll in 4-H but will not be allowed to exhibit at the Rock County Fair (Rock County 4-H Fair Policy).

Project Selection:

- A. 4-H members and leaders **MUST** use the current Rock County 4-H Project Guide to select project(s).
- B. If a project is not listed in the Rock County 4-H Project Guide or on 4HOnline, it is **not** offered in Rock County. Members may choose the self-study option and enroll in the Self-Determined project.
- C. There is no limit to the number of projects in which a 4-H member may enroll.
- D. Youth in 5K, 1st or 2nd grade MUST enroll as Cloverbuds and sign up for the Cloverbud project ONLY! Cloverbuds are NOT allowed to exhibit animals.

Membership Fees:

A. The annual membership fee for members in 3rd grade and older will be determined each year based on the Rock County 4-H Leaders Council budget. The membership fee for Cloverbuds and WSVH 4-H club members will be 25% of the membership fee for members in 3rd grade and older, rounded to the nearest whole dollar.

B. Membership fees:

Members in ^{3rd} grade and older - \$22.00. Cloverbuds, WSBVI and After School 4-H members - \$6.00.

C. **Club Leaders:** Please complete the "4-H Membership Fee Summary" form and submit it with your club's fees. All fees will be collected by the club and must be submitted to the Extension Office BY THE SECOND FRIDAY IN DECEMBER AND MONTHLY UPON ENROLLMENT FOR MEMBERS.
