

Adams County Horse & Pony Project Sportsmanship Award Nomination

The Wisconsin State 4-H Horse Association gives Sportsmanship Awards each year at the Wisconsin Horse Leaders Conference in November each year. Each county is asked to nominate one member for this award. The Adams county Youth Board is asking any member or enrolled leader to nominate someone using the attached form. You may sign your name or nominate anonymously. Each nominee will be assigned a number by the Project Secretary. The Youth Board will read all nominations and narrow the field to 5. They asked that the Executive Committee to pick the Adams County nominee from those five. No nominee names will be seen during the selection process, only their numbers.

- ❖ While choosing your nominee, think of someone who:
- ❖ Puts others before themselves
- ❖ Exhibits a sportsman-like attitude
- ❖ Puts in effort caring for their horse
- ❖ Puts others feelings before their own
- ❖ Is helpful to other and to the project
- ❖ Uses the horse project to grow as a person and as a 4-H member
- ❖ Shares their knowledge with others, especially teaching younger members basic horsemanship
- ❖ Accepts wins/losses with dignity and respect
- ❖ Is enthusiastic, honest and helpful
- ❖ Is a "Member in Good Standing"
- ❖ Volunteers to help with work parties, and non-competition events such as work parties, food booth, and Midwest Horse Fair

3. The entry form needs to be filled out completely, accurately and precisely
