

WISCONSIN SPIRIT TRIP Adams County 4-H



Objective: To provide an annual trip opportunity to Adams County 4-H youth grades 6-13 that will discover the history and unique opportunities found in Wisconsin. Trip will be 3 days and 2 overnights. Trip will rotate every year through the 4 different areas of Wisconsin. (Northwest, Northeast, Southwest and Southeast). Trip participants should expect to be active outdoors with the potential of tent camping.

- 1. Members will be exposed to the history of Wisconsin.
- 2. Members will be able to visit sites around Wisconsin.
- 3. Members will assist in the planning of the trip. Once members are selected the group will meet to decide what they would like to see in that area of the state and how they wish to enjoy the trip. Members will also plan the dates of the trip.
- 4. Members will have the opportunity to practice life skills of: responsibility, leadership, financial management, team work, self-responsibility, nurturing relationships, healthy lifestyle.

Application process: 4-H members will apply by application and letter of recommendation from club leader. 12 youth will be awarded the trip, with a minimum of 5. Applications are due April 1st by 4:30pm to the UW-Extension Office at 569 N. Cedar Street, Adams WI 53910. The Leaders Association Awards Committee will select youth based on their applications and scores

Cost: Approximate Cost per youth: \$100.00 - \$150.00

Youth will be responsible for spending money on the trip. Meals or partial meals will be included.

Transportation:

- 1. Transportation will be looked into depending on the number of youth attending.
- 2. University guidelines will be followed regarding transportation.

Chaperones: Each year we will ask for chaperones that wish to participate in this trip through an application process and selection done by the committee. There will be a minimum of 2 chaperones and a maximum of 3. A chaperone will be cpr/1st aid certified.

Responsibilities of Participants:

- participate in planning meetings
- report on assigned topics to share with the group in written and oral presentations
- follow through on assumed responsibilities by established deadlines
- show initiative when carrying out responsibilities during the trip
- be a team player when planning the trip and during the trip
- be a positive representative of Adams County and of 4-H.
