After much discussion on the location (behind exhibit building), the cost of concrete, electrical, water lines, garage doors, grading & the building itself the committee felt that the money set aside at this time (\$30,000 + \$5000) would not be enough to build. There was also concern of the committee recommendation of not doing platbooks that we may need the funding for future use in the 4-H program.

Tori asked Karen to contact ALM Charities (DL Gasser) and see if we could possibly still get the \$5000.00 from them to use to upgrade current building or possibly purchase some fans.
