1. Motion by Doreen Olson to approve minutes from October 27 meeting, second by Kay Olson. M/C
2. Review of Policies and Calendars for both committees
  - Discussion held on having committees start either in October or November. Advantage to get dates set for Education events to allow for items to be in the Newsletter in a timely manner
  - Also time updated added to calendar that meetings are proposed to be 1 hour or less.
