## ADAMS COUNTY 4-H – STANDING RULES

- 1) 4-H Clubs: Members/Leaders are expected to work in the Food Stand to raise funds for the Adams County 4-H Programs.
- 2) To be eligible to receive payment for working in the food stand, clubs must have at least 1 representative to help at either of the food stand clean-ups.
- 3) Trip winners are to pay 35% of the trip **by April 15<sup>th</sup>** to the Treasurer of the Adams County Leaders Assoc. Inc. If unable to pay by April 15<sup>th</sup> financial arrangements can be made with the Leaders Association Treasurer. Once youth present their experience at the Adams County Fair and 4-H Banquet, they can submit reimbursement for up to 10% of the 35% they paid. Starting for fiscal year 2024, trip winners will need to work a shift in the 4-H Food stand during the Adams County Fair in order to receive funding
- 4) Clubs will be paid \$ 25.00 for participation in a parade. Maximum \$25.00 per year.
- 5) Record Books & ME's forms are due to the Extension office on or before October 15th.
- Scholarship applications are due to the Extension office on or before April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 7) Any checks that are returned to the Leaders Association for insufficient funds will be charged a \$30.00 fee.
