In the afternoon, Dr. Henry Zerby, VP of Protein Procurement and Innovation at Wendy's, will speak on consumer trends. Rounding out the program we have Beth Ventura, University of Minnesota, and Jesse Robbins, Iowa State, talking about public perception of animal welfare.


