# Lower Menominee River Area of Concern Citizens Advisory Committee Meeting Minutes

#### **Action Items**

- 1. Ben will bring a copy of the new AOC display to the next CAC meeting and hand it off to Mark, Keith, or Trygve for exhibition at community buildings
- 2. Ben will ask CAC members to indicate their availability/interest in a spring waterfront cleanup, and select the best date possible
- 3. Trygve will report back to the group on potential for CAC/AOC involvement in the Bird City USA event
- 4. Keith will provide further details, including potential CAC involvement in the spring Lake Michigan Stakeholders Meeting in Marinette
- 5. Ben will ask the City of Marinette is they're interested in permanent outreach signage at 6<sup>th</sup> Street or Boom Landing on the sediment remediation projects
- 6. Sharon and Ben will request the fish passage partnership to develop a press release for the start of construction this season
- 7. Sharon and Ben will distribute minutes and develop an agenda for the next meeting

# Monthly TYCO Sediment Remediation Update - Jim Cox absent, no TYCO update

# Monthly WPSC Sediment Remediation Update – Jenny Short & Brian Bartoszek

- All coal has been removed
  - 25% more material was removed than anticipated
  - Some residual PAHs remain near cofferdam near Nest Egg Marine in the bedrock
  - A cap has been proposed, EPA is reviewing it
- Site Restoration
  - Shoreline vegetation will be re-established in spring
  - Outfall structure will be replaced
  - Reactive carbon mat down as barrier near former slough outfall
  - Asphalt repairs will be made, if needed, in spring
- Upland remediation
  - Remedial investigation has been submitted to EPA
  - Upland remediation will follow as needed
- Habitat restoration
  - Will re-establish upland vegetation
  - Not rebuilding sheet walls; will use rock riprap
    - Discussions ongoing with Brian Miller-Marinette
  - Nest Egg Marine has requested sheet wall placement along its property, approximately 85' of shoreline
    - WPSC is negotiating with Nest Egg, and may provide a cost share

- Post remediation depth
  - o If cap is approved as proposed, final depths will be approximately 6-8'
  - o Exact bathymetry can be shared once it's available
- Boat launch should be functional after ice-out

# Planning CAC Activities for 2013

- Keith will reserve meeting room for third Thursday of each month, 7-9pm central
- Signage and displays
  - Kiosks-Ben and Sharon are working with Chad Cook and the City of Marinette on kiosk development and installation
    - Menekaunee Harbor kiosk timeline for installation uncertain
  - Indoor display-see example in room
    - Sharon to bring one next time she travel to Menominee
    - Mark, Trygve, and Keith indicated that they would be happy to take the display to different places: city halls, college, libraries
- 2013 Waterfront Cleanup?
  - Strong interest from those attending
  - Need to select a date
    - Earth Day Saturday, April 20<sup>th</sup>
  - o Participant appreciation and other supplies on hand
  - Require support for trash disposal
- AOC Video
  - Shooting footage in summer of 2013
  - o Interviews will be requested from CAC members, not mandatory
  - Highlighting unique attributes of the Lower Menominee AOC
- Marinette is now a designated a "Bird City USA"
  - Chappee Rapids Audubon to hold celebratory event, an outreach opportunity for the CAC
- Lake Michigan Stakeholders Spring Meeting
  - o Group hoping to hold a meeting at UW-Marinette, May 22
  - Expecting ~60 participants
- Post remediation outreach
  - Letter from CAC
  - Cannot establish signage at SF sites (question from last month)
  - Will ask cities if they are interested
  - SF sites usually have a maker/monument noting the work
- Fish consumption advisory assessment ongoing
- Fish Passage Update-Ben and Sharon
  - Phases 1 & 2 work to begin this summer:
  - Downstream passage at Park Mill dam installing an angled bar rack and chute
  - Upstream passage at Menominee Dam installing the lift and sort station
  - Downstream at Menominee-2014
  - o F & W posters at City Halls
  - Kiosk at fishing area-3 years out
- Dredging
  - Should we keep monthly updates? Yes!
  - o WPSC plans to continue updates until restored
- Fish consumption-

- WDNR collecting fish for the MDEQ fish contaminant monitoring program to complete the 2012 collection needs
- GLNPO sediments team is expecting to sample sediments in the Upper Scott Flowage in 2013
- Refining Fish & Wildlife Habitat and Pops. Management Plan
  - We need to develop a focused list of habitat projects needing completion in order to remove these BUIs
    - EPA wants to see this before providing significant habitat related funding to avoid a "moving target"
  - Above and below the dams
  - Reliance on which species the fish biologist feel have habitat limitations
    - Plan target restorations for those species
    - Emphasis should be placed on fish populations and habitat
  - Habitat restoration after arsenic contaminated sediments removed
    - Discussed value and costs of arsenic removal and benthic habitat improvements between the current cleanup criteria of 50ppm and the final target of 20ppm
    - Discussed reconnection between south channel and Menekaunee Harbor

### **Agency Updates**

- Title/deed search progress or results
  - Sharon explained the Bay Abstract was having difficulty completing the project due to inadequate information from City
  - Mike Crammer-City of Menominee explained that he thought that Bay Title would be doing the work not his staff.
  - o Strawberry Islands BLM-will remain undeveloped
  - Blueberry Islands NAH-will manage as a natural area as part of the FERC
- Michigan PAC Support Grants
  - o Out soon
  - Need a fiduciary-working to develop a briefing for Marinette/Menominee
    Community Foundation to explain CAC need so the subject can be placed before board
