- <u>Returning members</u>: that are changing training levels must attend <u>at least 4</u> of the 9 Obedience Training classes.
- Three years or more training; any member and dog combination that has trained in the Dane County 4-H program for 3 or more years and is not changing training levels, training will be optional.

Showmanship Training Requirements:

- All new 4-H members wishing to show in any showmanship class at the Dane County Fair must attend at <u>least 6</u> of the 9 showmanship training classes.
- Any 4-H member and dog combination have trained in showmanship for 3 years in the Dane County 4-H program showmanship training is optional.
