The purpose of this clinic is to help riders improve their hunt and/or saddleseat riding skills. Emphasis will be on proper use of hands, legs, and seat. Please use appropriate tack (hunt or saddleseat) and wear appropriate attire for discipline. SEI helmet required.

About the Clinician: Over the past 30 years Betty has trained horses of different breeds, including AQHA & AQHYA World Champions, multiple WQHA Champions & State 4-H Champions. She has coached youth & amateur clients & their horses for all-around competition in western & hunt classes, including trail & over fences. Her students have qualified & competed on the youth teams at the All American Quarter Horse Congress & AQHYA World shows. Betty also showed on the Wisconsin Hunter/Jumper circuit for several years, earning year end awards. She holds judges cards from Wis. 4-H, Wisconsin Horse Council, POA and is a member of the AQHA Professional Horseman's Association.

Sessions are limited to 12 riders per session as described by experience level:

- 1 –2 PM **Walk/Trot & Novice Walk/Trot/Canter**—younger or newer members who have limited experience showing in walk/trot and/or beginning canter transitions, OR intermediate/advanced riders that have novice/green horses.
- 2:15 – 3:15 **Intermediate/Advanced** skill level: sitting & posting trot w/change of diagonals, extended trot, canter on correct leads.
- 3:30- 4:30 **Intermediate/Advanced** skill level: sitting & posting trot w/change of diagonals, extended trot, canter on correct leads.
