

ECONOMIC SNAPSHOT

Fewer local government jobs in Dane County

Between 1993 and 2003, the number of jobs in Dane County increased by 22.6 percent. During the same period, state and local government employment increased by only 6.4 percent. Since 1970, employment in the government sector as a percentage of total employment in Dane County has declined from 29 percent in 1970 to 19.2 percent in 2003.
