High gasoline prices affect everyone, but add only a few dollars to that weekend getaway to the Dells you have been planning, and only slightly more for the ski trip to Hurley you've been daydreaming about.

Calculations are based on a 79-cent-pergallon increase in gasoline prices between May 2004 and January 2006 and a Wisconsin average fuel efficiency of 22.2 miles per gallon
