
Comparing downtowns: hospitality industry employees

Downtown's lodging and food facilities serve a growing market segment composed of business and leisure travelers. According to the UW-Extension's market analysis, downtown Madison's visitors are served by over 1,200 lodging rooms and 190 eating/drinking places.

Note: 1-mile ring differs slightly from the Downtown Madison Study Area as defined in the UW-Extension Market Analysis.
