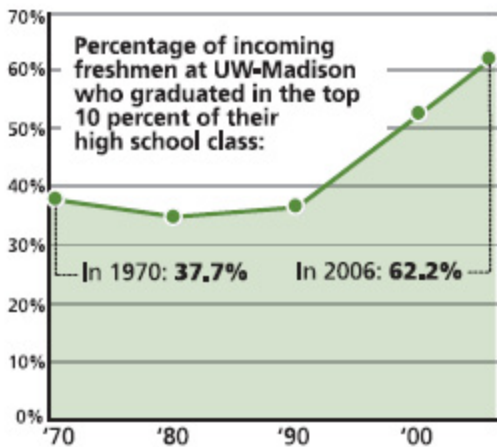

In 1970, 37.7 percent of the incoming freshmen at UW-Madison had graduated in the top 10 percent of their high school class. This school year, that number has risen to 62.2 percent.
