Canada: Our largest export market

In 2005, more than one-third of Wisconsin's \$5.2 billion in exports went to Canada. Top 10 Wisconsin exports to Canada:

Machinery manufacturers	\$1,513	37.4%
Transportation equipment	945	-1.6%
Paper products	478	19.8%
Computers and electronic products	338	6.3%
Processed foods	313	89.7%
Chemical manufacturers	244	23.9%
Elec. equipment, appliances, parts	204	19.3%
Plastic and rubber products	182	30.9%
Printing products	178	109.4%
Fabricated metal products	178	17.9%
Total exports	5,238	26.6%
