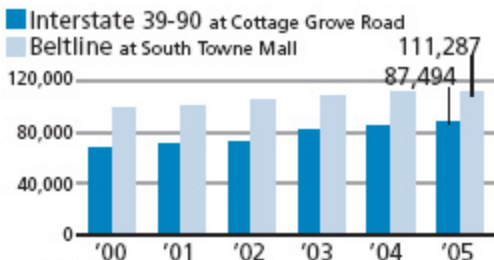


# ECONOMIC SNAPSHOT

## Traffic volume increasing on Madison's freeways

*In 2005, the Madison Beltline at South Towne Mall averaged 111,000 vehicles per day, an increase of 14 percent since 2000. Interstate 39-90 at Cottage Grove Road averaged 87,500 vehicles per day in 2005, an increase of 28 percent since 2000.*
