

# ECONOMIC SNAPSHOT

## Single servings

There are now more one-person households in the United States, Wisconsin and Madison than "traditional" married-couple households with children living at home. In the communities listed below, the percentage of single-person homes increased, and "traditional" households' percentage declined, between 1990 and 2000.

More one-person households influences everything from grocery stores to housing developments.
