- Individuals can win this scholarship only once.
- Two letters of recommendation are required to be mailed separately to the address indicated below. (Please note that recommendations should not come from family members or members of the Market Livestock Committee)
- The final application not exceeding 3 pages, using Times New Roman font with no smaller than a 10 point size.
- Scholarships will be distributed after receipt of a copy of the 1st term grades and 2nd term schedule.
- Scholarship Postmarked Deadline is April 15.
