










- Veterinary Client Patient Relationship

### Anaplasma marginale

- Not contagious
- Mechanical vectors: vet instruments, biting flies
- Biological vector: <u>Dermacentor</u> wood tick
- Tick control
- Carrier animals
  - Resistant calves
  - Fatal for cattle > 3 years old









## Neospora caninum

- Canines are the definitive host
- Cows are the intermediate host
  - Vertical transmission in cattle
  - Carrier calves appear normal
  - Abortion storms
- Vaccination
- ID chronic aborters







### Moraxella bovoculi

- Infectious Bovine Keratoconjunctivtis (IBK)
- Set of symptoms with multiple etiologies
- Underlying irritation to the eye:
  - Flies, UV light, and grass
- Vaccination
- Prevention
- Treatment



Pinkeye - severe inflammation of the eye



#### **Zoonotic Threats**

- Fasiola hepatica, Fascioloides magna
  - Limit access to snail infested areas near water
  - Limit deer access
- Leptospirosis: *L. hardjo*
- Rabies
