30 DAY HARVEST NOTIFICATION AND ESTIMATED HARVEST DATE

- 30 Day Harvest Notification/Estimated Harvest Date.
 - Notify the program via Email DATCPIndustrialhemp@wisconsin.gov or phone 608-224-4629.
 - Mail: DATCP, Hemp Program, PO Box 8911, Madison, WI 53708
 - Include: License number, your name and phone number, location of the crop, names of varieties to be tested, expected harvest date.
 - We require this lead-time to schedule staff sampling assignments. *Last minute sampling requests could result in delayed sampling of your crop*

- Two Planting Report Forms (Field) (Greenhouse/Indoor)
- Planting Reports must be submitted within 30 days after planting OR by July 5, whichever comes first.
- Submit the planting report as soon as you plant.
- ***Avoid license suspension by submitting a planting report that indicates that you have not planted yet.***

This form must be completed and submitted in order to modify growing acreage or location or processing location. Amendment fees may apply. No hemp growing or processing is authorized at locations not registered for the current growing season with the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection's Hemp Program.

NOTE: If you have more than one location to register at this time, submit additional copies of this form. **The first license amendment or set of license amendments received on the same date may have the license amendment fee waived. All subsequent license amendments may incur a fee of \$50. Additional license fees will be assessed if growing acreage exceeds the amount included in the license.**

HEMP SAMPLING & TESTING

- Each field and variety sampled and tested by DATCP
- Each sample must test at or below 0.3% THC
- One re-test per failed field or variety is allowed
- Must destroy crops for any fields or varieties that fail
- Fit For Commerce certificate issued for crops that pass the regulatory test

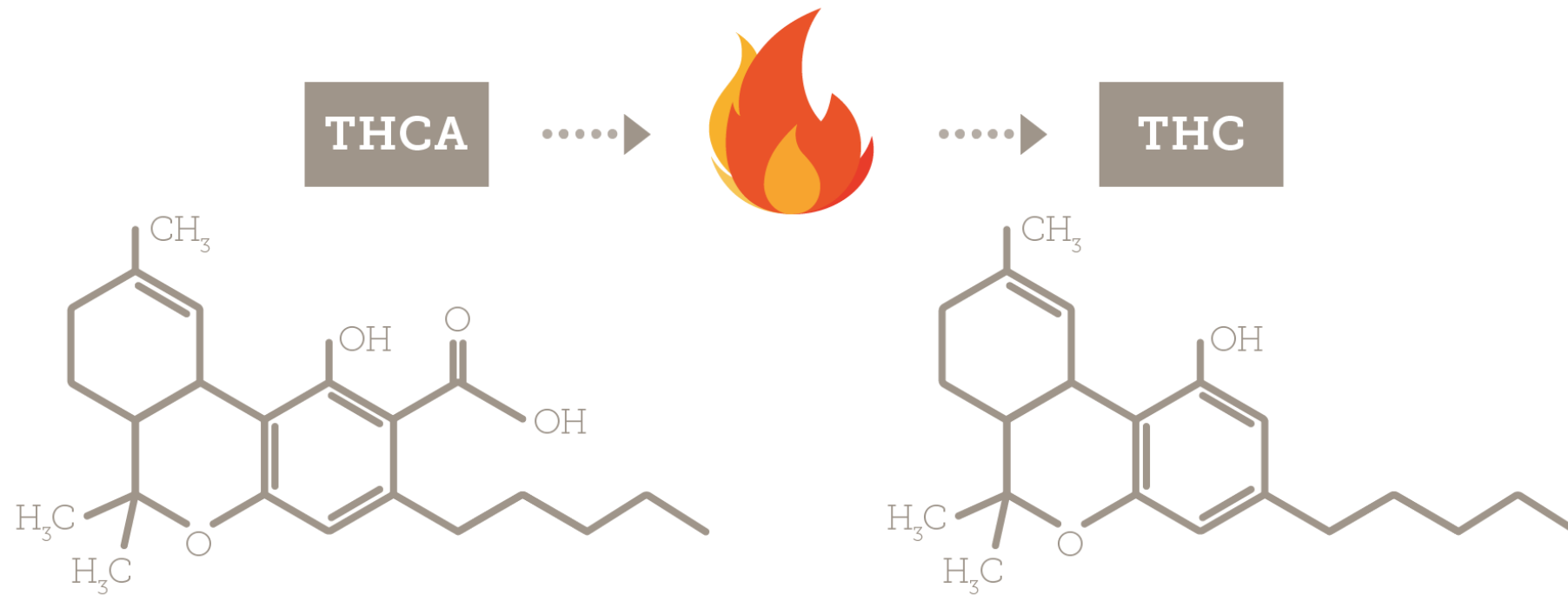

- Official regulatory samples tested by DATCP
- Pre-regulatory tests by private laboratories
- Gas Chromatography
- HPLC (High Performance Liquid Chromatography)
