

2019 Goat Essay Questions - Kewaunee County 4-H Livestock Auction

Due Date: Due date for ALL livestock essay submissions is June 3, at 4:30 pm. All submissions MUST be in the UW-Extension office by this date and time, NO EXCEPTIONS.

Essay Submission: Essays can be submitted via email to: dahle.erin@kewauneeco.org, or by mailing to or dropping off at Kewaunee County 4-H, 810 Lincoln St., Kewaunee, WI 54216.

Confirmation: Erin will confirm that she received your document. If you do not get a confirmation email from her within 48 hours (she will not respond on the weekend), it is your responsibility to follow-up with her to make sure she has received it. Please, do not send these documents to Jill, Aerica, Louise, or any 4-H leader. They need to be submitted to Erin.

IMPORTANT (if this is not included, it is not submitted):

- All documents must include first and last name, current grade, and species as listed below. It should be the first thing listed on the top of your essay.
Example: Chris Clover, Grade 9, Sheep
- If you e-mail your essay, the email subject line and file should be titled with: Species (list your species) Essay, First Name and Last Name.
Example: Sheep Essay Chris Clover
- If you have questions about how to do any of this, please give Erin a call at (920)388-7141 and she will absolutely help you through it

A few tips and reminders:

- All work must be original and not copied directly from another member, source, or the internet.
- A few words of advice: Don't wait until 4:30pm on June 3rd to turn it in. You can turn it in any time before the deadline.

What happens if I don't turn it in? Failure to turn in your essay will result in the inability to sell your animal in the auction held during the Kewaunee County Fair.

An additional incentive to write a great essay: All essays will be read and the best will be selected from each age group to receive a special award (they have been really good in the past!)

Do I need to write an essay for each species I intend to sell? Yes, you need to write an essay for each species you intend to sell. So, if you intend to show swine and beef, you need to write an essay for each one.

Goat Essay Scoring Rubric

Criteria used in judging:

- 1) Appearance of the essay, neatness
Easy to read, no fringed edges, no crossed out words
- 2) Contains the minimum number of words as required
- 3) Question was answered accurately
Facts about goats and goat care were correct ;
- 4) Shows knowledge of goats
Included personal experience with your own goat/s
- 5) Correct spelling and grammar
