Dear 4-H Dairy Member,

It is that time of year again when 4-H members turn their attention to dairy judging. Practices for the 2023 dairy judging teams will be held in March and April at five locations. Junior judging age requirements are 9-13 years of age as of Jan. 1, 2023. Senior team member age requirements are 14–19 years of age as of Jan 1, 2023.

We realize some individuals will not be able to attend all the workshops because of schedule conflicts. We ask that participants attend a minimum of 3 workshops in order to be eligible to make the final team and attend a sectional judging contest in June. However, an excused absence will be granted to senior team members if they are unable to attend the workshops, due to attendance at post-secondary education schools. The attendance at these judging practices do count as educational meetings. The auction committee rules can be found at www.kewaunee.uwex.edu/4-h-youth-development/kew. The dairy committee rules are that an individual must attend one dairy meeting and complete a managerial record to show at the fair and have attended two dairy meetings to be in the auction. Three dairy judging practices will count as two dairy meetings.
