Qualifications:

- Must be an approved, Kewaunee County 4-H member in good standing at the time of application.
- Open to horse project members in grades 12 & 13.
- You can only receive this scholarship once. Previous recipients are not eligible to apply.
- **Applications must be submitted as PDF documents or typed and submitted as a hardcopy.**

Please note: All applications will be judged based on the guidelines attached. Winners will be notified and then announced at the annual leaders' association banquet. Winners must submit their Fall transcripts (official or unofficial) to the adult leaders' association treasurer. After the transcripts are received, scholarship funds will be distributed to the winner at the beginning of their Spring semester in higher education.
