Qualifications:

- This scholarship is open to members in grades 12 or 13. *Applicants may apply twice and receive this scholarship twice.*
- Applications **must** be submitted as PDF documents or typed and submitted as a hardcopy.

Please note: All applications will be judged based on the guidelines attached. Winners will be notified and then announced at the annual Leaders' Association banquet and high school graduation if applicable. Winners must submit their Fall transcripts to the adult Leaders' Association treasurer (official or unofficial). After the transcripts are received, scholarship funds will be distributed to the winner at the beginning of their Spring semester in higher education.
