Winners will be notified and then announced at the annual leaders' association banquet and applicable high school graduation. Winners must submit their Fall transcripts to the adult Leaders' Association treasurer (official or unofficial). After the transcripts are received, scholarship funds will be distributed to the winner at the beginning of their Spring semester in higher education.
