

Kewaunee County 4-H Horse Project Scholarship

Deadline: Wednesday, April 1, 2026

Award: One \$500.00 scholarship may be awarded each year.

Qualifications:

- Must be an approved, Kewaunee County 4-H member in good standing at the time of application.
- Open to horse project members in grades 12 & 13 with a minimum of four consecutive years in the horse project.
- You can only receive this scholarship once. Previous recipients are not eligible to apply.
- **Applications must be submitted as PDF documents or typed and submitted as a hardcopy.**

Please note: All applications will be judged based on the guidelines attached. Winners will be notified and then announced at the annual Leaders' Association banquet and high school graduation if applicable. Winners must submit their Fall transcripts (official or unofficial) to the Kewaunee County 4-H Horse Project treasurer. After the transcripts are received, scholarship funds will be distributed to the winner at the beginning of their Spring semester in higher education.
