

# Kewaunee County 4-H Livestock Association Scholarship

Return Completed Application by Wednesday, April 1, 2026

Eligibility requirements: must be in grade 12 or 13 and have sold at the auction for a minimum of 2 years.

**Award:** Up to two (2) \$1,000 scholarships may be awarded each year.

## **Qualifications:**

- Must have sold at the Kewaunee County Fair Auction a minimum of 2 years (consecutive or not)
- Must be an approved Kewaunee County 4-H member in good standing or 4-H participant in the Kewaunee County Livestock Auction at the time of application.
- The scholarship is open to members and Kewaunee County 4-H Livestock Auction participants in grades 12 or 13.
- You may apply for this scholarship in both grades 12 and 13, but you may only receive the award once.
- **Applications must be submitted as PDF documents or typed and submitted as a hardcopy.**

**Please note:** All applications will be judged based on the guidelines attached. Winners will be notified and then announced at the annual Leaders' Association banquet and high school graduation if applicable. Winners must submit their Fall transcripts to the Livestock Association treasurer (official or unofficial). After the transcripts are received, scholarship funds will be distributed to the winner at the beginning of their Spring semester in higher education.

### **Two letters of recommendation**

- One letter must be from a Project Leader, Club Leader, Advisor (someone who describes your project work quality, leadership skills and experience, sportsmanship, etc.) **not from a relative.**
- One letter must be from any other source (employer, teacher, school advisor, clergy) **not from a relative.**
