A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Wisconsin State Statutes section 125.06(6), no license or permit is required for the sale of fermented malt beverages in any public park operated by a county or municipality; and

WHEREAS, under that same statute section, fermented malt beverages shall be sold by officers or employees of the county or municipality under ordinance, resolution, rule or regulation enacted by the governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks, Energy and Environment, at its meeting on December 8, 2009, recommended adoption of the said request (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize Milwaukee County officers or employees to sell fermented malt beverages in public parks operated by Milwaukee County.
