The science of phenology addresses the connection between the development of plants and insects, plus other biological events with weather-based phenomenon. It is an ancient science that has remarkable utility in tracking effects of climate change as well as helping us to keep ahead of insects and diseases using its predictive information. Learn how to calculate degree days and how they tie in with insect and plant development. You will also be given resources about phenology to delve deeper into the science.
