Fellow Fruit Growers,

There is nothing more satisfying than picking sweet, fresh fruit from your very own tree. Therefore, again this year we are pleased to bring you our list of fruit trees, asparagus and berries that we will have available for your selection in 2020

Let's start with some of the most often asked question about our fruit trees.

- The trees are bare root (no soil on the roots when delivered).
- All apple trees are grafted on EMLA 7, G-41, Bud 9 & 10 rootstock (semi-dwarfing and dwarfing).
- Tree size is between 4'-6' tall, depending on the cultivar.
- The trunk diameter is 1/2" - 5/8" and most will be well branched, once again depending on the cultivar.

There will be Master Gardener Volunteers at the pick-up site who can assist you with answering any questions you might have regarding the handling, planting, and care of your new trees.

ORDER EARLY: Tree varieties are pre-ordered and available inventory is limited to what we have already ordered. Although we order over 1000 trees, quantities are limited. Orders will be filled in the order they are received.
