## Step 3

Different people need different amounts of time to study. We recommend giving yourself 30 days to cover the material. Focus on the "Learning Objectives." Training materials are generally reviewed and updated in 5-year cycles.

Gray boxes are not testable content, but provide good information to have as reference.

### The certification exam is provided by DATCP.

- The exam is given by the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP). There are several testing centers around the state.
- There are no additional fees for the exam or retesting.
- Exams have approximately 70 multiple choice questions. You have 90 minutes to take the test.
- To take the exam you need:
  - a. Photo identification
  - b. Provide your SSN (state law).
  - c. Provide your Training Registration Certificate.
