Dual-Notice Pesticides Registered for use in Wisconsin

- DO NOT USE THIS TABLE AS A SUBSTITUTE FOR READING THE PESTICIDE LABEL. The information in this table may not be complete and is intended for reference only.
- For some active ingredients listed here, there may be formulations which are not dual-notice pesticides.
- Don't automatically assume that a dual-notice pesticide is also classified as a restricted-use pesticide, or visa versa, these are not the same thing.

A dual-notice pesticide is a pesticide whose label, in the Agricultural Use Requirements box, requires the agricultural employer (i.e., farmer) to notify non-family agricultural workers both orally **and** by posting that a site has been treated with that pesticide. For example, "Notify workers of the application by warning them orally and by posting warning signs at entrances to treated areas." Wisconsin law (ATCP 29) further requires that the applicator post any area treated with a dual-notice pesticide if that site borders within 300 feet of a nonagricultural area where persons are likely to be present (e.g., residence, schools) during the application and/or the restricted-entry interval specified on the pesticide label.
