- 1. Sheep Gates
 - a. Pens have been ordered.
 - i. Total purchase cost should be \$16,875.00 from Sydell with trucking included

 - c. Donations

- 2. Printer for Fair
 - a. Liz provided information and options on both ink jet and laser multi-function printers Black and White as well as color. General discussion was that Laser multi-function machine would be beneficial as nearly the same cost and ink doesn't dry out and provides faster, clearer printing, as well as copy/scan features. Device must be both Wi-Fi and wire capable. Will look at Office Depot or Staples so Extension office can purchase directly and withdraw funds from account.
