- 2. Initial Weigh-Ins: Ag Society going to mandate initial weigh-ins with Rate of Gain Will need further discussion on whether the Rate of Gain will be mandatory to sell or show.
 - a. Beef: Feb 25th 9-Noon at Paul McClone's with make up date of March 4th 9-Noon
 - i. M: Scott Breitrick, 2nd: Bill Inman, Vote: Approved
 - b. Sheep and Goat: May 11th 5-7pm at the Fairgrounds
 - i. M: Eli Inman, 2nd: Allison Brown, Vote: Approved
 - c. Futher discussion will be needed on recommended Rate of Gain Amounts per specie.
 - i. Roy Wilson stated .25/day for 110 days on Sheep would be acceptable.
 - ii. Bill Bohn to find out more info on Goats but should be less than Sheep.
 - iii. Beef:
 - 1. Beef and Possible Heifer Class 2 ½ /day @ 180 days
 - 2. Dairy 2 /day @ 180 days
 - 3. Dairy x Beef 2 ¼ /day @ 180 days
- 3. Beef Show Times: No Dairy meeting yet so not able to get any additional information relating to their time of arrival. Scott thinks Livestock Committee should meet with Dairy Committee to discuss. Livestock Committee needs to seriously consider 1 day for showing.
- 4. Market Heifer Class: Other counties do have market class. Need 3 or more animals to make class work. Would be Beef x Beef only. No Crossbred or Dairy. If we add class, need to add to awards listing.
- 5. 2 Swine Possibility: 1 pig per child in 2021 and 2022. If in the Swine project for 1st or 2nd year, only allowed to bring one swine max. If in the project more than 2 years, then 2 swine allowed. See cake decorating rules for similar wording on exclusions/exceptions. Wording similar to: Must be enrolled in Swine Project for more than 2 consecutive years to bring 2 pigs.
- 6. Work vs Educational Credit: Can be Pre, Post (Clean up day only) or During Fair
 - a. Recommended 3 Educational Credits (YQCA and 2 others) along with 1 Work Credit
- 7. Terminal vs Non-terminal: Ask for input at Informational meeting. Ropes/PRV's test approx. \$65-90
- 8. Tuesday Animal Drop-off: Ag Society said No, not an option.

Once decided, #2-6 will be rolled out at Mandatory Informational Meeting. Mandatory Meeting will be for both students enrolled in Livestock and the Parent(s) of that student. Two meeting options to be held. Tuesday, Feb 7th and Saturday Feb 11th - Locations TBD. Meeting will start with Information then break out into 3 categories – Beginner, Intermediate, Senior.

Other New Business: Area EMS/Fire Departments looking to put on Farm Safety Courses – looking to raise funds of approx. \$6500. Please contact Megan if you know of anyone wishing to donate.
