

Shawano County 4-H Livestock Committee Scholarship

The Shawano County 4-H Livestock Committee Scholarship supports and rewards youth for their involvement in sheep, beef, swine and/or goat projects. Scholarships are used by recipients to further their education in a post-secondary school.

The scholarships are based on one-half of the donated back income from the Shawano 4-H Livestock Auction, plus the interest on the accounts. The total is allocated among the top five applicants.

Eligibility

The applicant must be in grades 11 – 13 and involved in a Shawano County sheep, beef, swine and/or goat project. Applicants may apply for any or all three years but can only receive the scholarship once, regardless of placing.

Selection Process

Applications are available online at <https://fyi.extension.wisc.edu/shawano4h/awardstripsscholarships/> and are due May 31. Selections are announced during the Shawano County Fair. The scholarships will be paid upon receipt of a transcript showing completion of the fall semester and proof of registration for the spring semester. The scholarship will be paid directly to the school. Failure to provide a transcript, proof of registration and financial aid mailing information by December 20 will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.

Basis for Selection

- 1. Livestock Project – 40 points**
 - Knowledge of project
 - Management practices
 - Knowledge gained through participation
 - Scope of project
- 2. Participation in ag youth organizations and livestock related activities – 25 points**
 - 4-H and FFA involvement and community service projects
 - Livestock activities
 - Membership in breed associations or producer groups
- 3. Future goals – 5 points**
 - Realistic career and educational goals
- 4. How livestock experiences have helped set future goals – 15 points**
- 5. Participation in non-livestock activities – 10 points**
 - School, church and or community activities
- 6. Letter of recommendation – 5 points**
 - No immediate family member

Letter of Recommendation

Submit a letter of recommendation along with the application. The letter of recommendation should be included in a sealed envelope from the reference. Please do not use a family member for a reference.

Photograph

Include a professional-looking, high-quality headshot photograph with your completed application for publicity purposes.

Agreement

Scholarship recipients have one year from the date they graduate from high school, or a year after their first year of post-secondary school, to claim their scholarship. The scholarship is payable for the second semester of the academic school year.

I understand if I receive a scholarship:

- I will submit a transcript showing completion of the fall semester and proof of registration for the spring semester. I will also provide my student ID number and financial aid office mailing information to the Shawano County UW-Extension Office by December 20.
- A check for the total of the scholarship will be paid directly to my post-secondary school.
- If I do not meet the above conditions, I will forfeit my scholarship.
