Are reflectors clean, unfaded and undamaged?								
If tractor to be operated by No Fee Permit on highway, is permit available to operator?								
Have defective mufflers and other exhaust components been replaced?								
Is the drawbar in proper position?								
Is each tractor equipped with a 10-pound (minimum) ABC type fire extinguisher?								
Are cab windows and mirrors clean to maintain clear visibility?								
Are tires in good condition and inflated to the recommended pressure?								
Can brakes be locked together for road travel?								
Does the parking brake work?								
Are controls clearly marked and gauges working properly?								
Have employees had training on safe operation? [Reference: OSHA 1928.51 (d)]								

Have operators been instructed on seatbelt use? [Ref: OSHA 1928.51 (b)(2)]			
Is the operator's manual available to operators?			
Is a first-aid kit available?			
Have emergency procedures been provided to operators?
