**Leadership Washington Focus: Youth currently in grades 6-8 may participate in this program. The 4-H leadership program will take place at the National 4-H Youth Conference Center outside of Washington, D.C. Participants are immersed in the culture and history through on-site workshops and tour D.C.s most spectacular sights. The dates for the trip are July 26-31.
