#### Wildlife & Forestry 4-H Friends.

Do you want to help the Monarch butterflies? Do you know the 4 other common names it has depending on the region you are in? Why not collect milkweed seeds for planting in the spring? Remember, when collecting milkweed seeds take 1/3 and leave 2/3 of the ripe brown milkweed pods on the plants. Take your camera along for interesting photo opportunities. On a cold winter day, you can remove the seeds from the white fluff indoors.

Congratulations to the 2018 Wisconsin 4-H Forestry Team. The national 4-H contest was held at Jackson Mill, Weston, West Virginia. Wisconsin 4-H team members were Taylor Champeau (Washington Co.), Lyta Nicoll (Waukesha Co.), Micah Stege (Washington Co.) & Philip Mayer (Washington Co.). Next year, we plan to send a team of four youth to the National 4-H Forestry Contest and four youth to the National 4-H Wildlife Habitat Education Program Contest. Youth may participate in the national contests only one time in their 4-H career. Al Gross and Robin Champeau are the Wisconsin 4-H Forestry state team coaches.

Wildlife WHEP and FORESTRY Contests - April 5 & 6, 2019 - Participation is open to all enrolled Wisconsin 4-H club members. Let us know and we'll show you how easy it is to prepare for the contests. This contest is an opportunity for you to become familiar with the wildlife habitat education program competition and the forestry program competition. Request registration forms by email. The ecoregion for the wildlife contest will be announced later. The forestry contest is on Forestry Basic Information and Management. The contest questions will be multiple choices. It's a great way to test your knowledge against others in your age group. Wildlife WHEP - (5 topics): Wildlife Management Practices; Concepts & Terms; Wildlife ID; Foods ID; & Management Plan. Forestry - (5 topics): Compass & Topo Maps; Tree Identification; Tree Health -Insects/Diseases; Tree Measurement; & Forest Evaluation. The registration deadline is March 16th.

Older youth can qualify for National 4-H Competition by participating in the contests. Participation in 2019 can qualify you for the 2020 team. Wisconsin plans to send a team of four 4-H youth to the National 4-H WHEP Contest in late July. Another 4-H team will be going to the National 4-H FORESTRY Contest at the same time.
