

Wisconsin 4-H Horse Association Scholarship

Description:

Up to six scholarships may be awarded if applicable.

Eligibility:

- A. High school seniors and post-secondary students currently in their first year of higher education are eligible to apply.
- B. A minimum GPA 2.0 out of 4.0 is required to redeem your scholarship.
- C. A minimum of four consecutive years in the 4-H Horse & Pony Project (regular member or horseless horse).
- D. Applicants must attend an accredited, post-secondary school/program (i.e. 2- or 4-year collage or professional technical program, Farm & Industry short course program, vocational college or training of at least one school year in length).
- E. Applicants may pursue any major.

Minimum Requirements for Application:

- A. Two letters of recommendation (signed with their title)
 - 1. Project or club leader (quality of project work, leadership, role model).
 - 2. One from any other source (employer, teacher, school advisor, clergy) **not** from relative.
- B. Application
- C. Summary questionnaire

Comments:

- A. All scholarship forms and letters of reference must be postmarked by March 1.

- B. Scholarship recipients will be notified by mail.
- C. Scholarships will be paid in the name of the school, or the school and the recipient after one semester is completed.
- D. Previous recipients of the Wisconsin 4-H Horse Association Scholarship are not eligible to apply.
