- 2) Complete online application at <http://wi.4honline.com> Please note: Applications will be found under "events".
- 3) Submit team specific materials as required (see below).

All applications and other required materials must be received by **December 20, 2019**.

PLEASE NOTE: Each state team has Team Specific Instructions.

ART TEAM: In addition to completing the online application, please email 4 photos of your artwork, with each labeled with age, date, and medium it was created in, to Stephanie Kempe at kempesteph@gmail.com.

DRAMA COMPANY: In addition to completing the online application, please email two letters of recommendation to Lynn Pfeiffer at lynn.pfeiffer@wisc.edu and put *Drama Company* in the Subject. Returning members only need to have one letter. Have the letters address your leadership, 4-H experience, theatre experience (including dance, music, and technical skills) and ability to work with others in a creative setting.

COMMUNICATION TEAM: In addition to completing the online application, please email the following to Lynn Pfeiffer at lynn.pfeiffer@wisc.edu and put *Communications Team* in the Subject:

- 1) Description of your work in one of the following areas: design, photography, videography, social media or writing and describe how you would like to use your communication talents to tell the story of 4-H in Wisconsin.
- 2) Samples of your work in one of the four focus areas: design (3 design samples), photography (three digital photographs), videography (two, 2-3 minute video clips that have been edited) or writing (two 1-2 page essays you've written for school or 2, 1-2 page creative writing projects or 2 articles you've written about your 4-H club or group.) Each writing sample should be double-spaced using a 12 pt. font.
- 3) Two letters of recommendation.
