# REGISTRATION

### WHO SHOULD ATTEND

Teams of high-school-age youth (ages 14-18) and adults (21 or older) sharing decision-making roles in communities, schools and organizations (19 to 20 year olds are also welcome but should register as adults.)

Groups are limited to 10 people with the preferred ratio of 4 youth to one adult.

### **NEXT STEPS:**

Identify a team of youth and adults who intend to work together after the conference. Registration opens September 5 and the cost will be \$120, which includes meals and lodging and needs based scholarships are available.
