

2019 Wisconsin 4-H Space Camp Counselor Information

4-H Missions in Space, Huntsville, Alabama

Enjoy the satisfaction of helping others while developing and practicing leadership, organizational, public speaking, and mentoring skills as you explore the fascinating world of robotics and technology on a National 4-H program. Be a Wisconsin 4-H Space Camp Counselor during a fun-filled program at U.S. Space & Rocket Center in Huntsville, AL. ***Counselors provide leadership and support to campers en route to and from camp and participate in a robotics program at the U.S. Space & Rocket Center. The Space Camp Robotics Trainee Program incorporates real-world applications of STEM to equip participants to be future space and research leaders. Trainees learn what it's like to engineer and design robots on land, in the air, and underwater.***

Selection Procedure: Interested past delegates to the Space Camp Program are invited to apply for a leadership role on the 2019 Wisconsin 4-H Space Camp Counselor Team by November 15, 2018. A committee will review applications, conduct interviews, make selections, and announce the 2019 Wisconsin 4-H Space Camp Counselor Team. There is no pre-established number of selected recipients; instead the number of selections is based on qualifications and number needed for 2019 Space Camp. All applicants will be notified of their status by mail and email. **New in 2019: the final counselor team will not be selected until after the February 16th training workshop. Candidates must participate in all aspects of the program in order to be considered for a final counselor position.**

Criteria for Selection

1. Must be in 8th through 10th grade (maximum age 16 at end of experience.)
2. Must have good verbal communication and leadership skills, and work well in groups.
3. Must complete and submit the following application to your county 4-H Office no later than **November 15, 2018**.
4. Must participate in a telephone interview. (A Selection Committee member will contact finalists.)
5. Participation in the Wisconsin 4-H Space Camp Program is ideal.

Roles/Duties- Wisconsin 4-H Space Camp Counselors are required to:

1. Participate in Counselor Training Zoom 7:00-8:30 p.m. **January 27 and 7:00-8:30 p.m.**
2. Participate in the Delegate Orientation (date/format TBD).
3. Participate in the camp counselor training workshop on **February 16, 2019** at a central location to be determined.
4. Participate in a mandatory face-to-face training workshop on Saturday morning through Sunday afternoon, **March 30-31, 2019** at the Comfort Inn & Suites in Deforest, WI. (10:15 a.m. Saturday- 4 p.m. Sunday)
5. Attend and participate in the workshop for Space Campers between 1:30-3:30 p.m. Sunday, **March 31, 2019** at Comfort Inn & Suites, Deforest to set up, assist with a Question/Answer table, facilitate, and lead an Aerospace project activity.
6. Participate in the WI program at Space Camp departing the morning of **Thursday, April 25** and returning **Monday, April 29, 2019**.
7. Arrive 1 hour before listed loading time to assist at departure with luggage, nametags, bus check-in, and other duties.
8. Take attendance on bus following initial orientation and at other stops.
9. Provide a self-introduction and host an informal Question/Answer session on the bus.
10. Plan and conduct at least two icebreakers/games that can be conducted during the bus trip.
11. Be responsible for ensuring that the bus is kept clean throughout the experience.
12. Assist with directions upon arrival at Space Camp.
13. Serve as a resource and mentor to assigned 6th-8th grade Space Campers and answer questions as needed.
14. Form an Adult/Youth Partnership with an adult 4-H volunteer advisor to assist with the program. Adults are active 4-H volunteers who have completed WI 4-H Youth Protection, selected from an applicant pool in March and trained for their role.

Program details: During this program, you will travel on a motor coach originating near Eau Claire, Wausau, Madison and/or Milwaukee to and from Huntsville, Alabama, eat in restaurants and a camp cafeteria, share same-gender sleeping and restroom facilities, and sleep in double or bunk beds. At camp, you will work with a team of 12-15 similar aged youth to help them solve problems and work through a robotics program. Counselors work under the guidance of adult advisors and spend the majority of their time under the direct supervision of adult 4-H volunteers, Wisconsin 4-H staff, and Space Camp staff adult counselors. Adult Advisors are assigned at a ratio of 1:10 youth and at least one adult of the same gender will be housed per floor. Both genders will be housed on the same floor. The health staff is a Wisconsin 4-H adult volunteer who has first aid/CPR training. You may be able to experience some or all of the following activities: train like the pioneers of Mercury, Gemini, and Apollo; tumble and spin in a Multi-Axis Trainer; float on air in a 5-Degrees of Freedom Chair; walk like Apollo astronauts in a 1/6th Gravity Chair; experience a world without friction in the MMU – Manned Maneuvering Unit; explore the past, present and future of space flight; and experience a giant screen IMAX® theater. Activities may also include large group games and running which allow personal contact with other counselors and campers; walking or standing for several hours on concrete floors or sidewalks; climbing on an indoor climbing wall with safety equipment; writing; public speaking; and performing skits in front of an audience.
