**2020 4-H Muzzleloading Workshop  
For Youth & Parents Welcomed  
Includes National Qualifying Event-NQE**

*Saturday, September 19, 2020*

*Starting Time: 8:00 AM Sharp*

*Hosted by Chippewa County 4-H Shooting Sports*

4-H Youth and their Parents in Wisconsin are being offered a chance to learn traditional and modern muzzle loading rifle and pistol shooting. The workshop will be at Tilden Township, Bloomer, Wisconsin.

The workshop is run by a long-time muzzle loading instructor and the WI 4-H Muzzle loading Project Course and National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association (NMLRA) Basic Muzzle Loading Course will be used. Using both cap lock, flintlock rifles, and muzzle loading shotgun, both safety and shooting fundamentals will be taught. Depending on enrollment numbers, we could also use pistols and cap and ball revolver. For those interested in hunting, points on hunting loads will be given.

**EQUIPMENT** The 4-H Program will supply all guns and supplies. You are welcome and encouraged to bring your own equipment, but we will inspect it for safeness before use.

**SAFETY EQUIPMENT NEEDED** Everyone on the range **must wear eye protection**, whether shooting or not. **Ear protection is required**. If you have earplugs or muffs, bring them. We have safety equipment but it works better if you bring your own.

**NQE** All youth participants will participate in the National Qualifying Event (NQE). After all the NQE's are finished throughout the state, the top shooter will be invited to represent Wisconsin in the National 4-H Shoot in 2021. A wildlife event will be included.

**REGISTRATION FEE** \$20.00 per participant. Parents and Grandparents are welcome to register for the workshop. Fee is due by September 8, 2020. Please bring a sack lunch.
