8	Whereas, agriculture and farmland are important to our community by generating economic revenue,
9	providing important environmental benefits, maintaining our rural character and open spaces, and by
10	contributing to our quality of life; and

12	Whereas, agricultural land continues to be converted to other uses as the population moves out into
13	the more rural agricultural areas of our community; and
14	
15	Whereas, the La Crosse County Board of Supervisors is in the process of developing a farmland
16	preservation program designed specifically for this county; and
17	Whomes the County may qualify to making matching funds from State and Endand magnetic for
18	Whereas, the County may qualify to receive matching funds from State and Federal programs for
19 20	farmland preservation; and
21	Whereas, according to the County Farmland Preservation Program Draft, (1) individual municipalities
22	must first pass a resolution authorizing landowner participation, (2) each landowner application must
23	also be approved by the municipality to be considered by the County, and (3) protection of farmland
24	must be consistent with adopted comprehensive land use plans in order to avoid preserving land better
25	suited for commercial, industrial or high-density residential development; and
26	suited for commercial, industrial of high density residential development, and
27	Whereas, the County Farmland and Open Space Preservation Draft offers a voluntary option for
28	owners of farmland outside of planned urban growth areas that are interested in protecting their
29	farmland by participating in the purchase of development rights program;
30	
31	Therefore be it resolved that the governing body of supports the efforts of the La
32	Crosse County Board to establish and fund an active farmland preservation program in La Crosse
33	County and encourages landowners who own land that should be preserved to apply to this program.
